Following our parents' consultation evening on the 15th December 2009 and the positive response from you, we are now in the exciting position to start the 'Healthzone' drop-in at the Aylesbury Vale Academy.

The Healthzone co-ordinator and partners will visit the Academy during assemblies promoting the drop-in and involving the young people in its steering group. As previously stated the Healthzone offers a range of health and emotional support as well as sexual health information this could include condom distribution, pregnancy and Chlamydia testing. Healthzones are a government initiative to reduce teenage pregnancy and sexually transmitted diseases and it runs alongside SRE & PHSEE which will be compulsory in September 2011.

All the workers are specifically trained in this field and will use Fraser competency and age appropriate guidelines. In this respect parents/carers are invited to express their opinions regarding this issue and the services on offer.
