Dear Parent/Carer,

As we get closer to the formal summer Year 11 exam season, we wanted to write you with the arrangements for your child, in order to support them in their revision.

Firstly, Year 11 will leave the Academy on the afternoon of **Thursday 20 May 2010**.

On Friday the 21 May, there will be revision sessions for Science for small numbers of students in the morning and in readiness for some exams in the afternoon. The following week we will run revision sessions for their optional subjects, as follows:

Monday - Option C subjects

Tuesday - Option A subjects

Wednesday - Option E subjects

Thursday - Option D subjects

Friday - Option B subjects

Any student attending must come in full Academy uniform.

Students will be targeted for support and therefore expected to attend on those days.

I remind all parents/carers and students that until students have physically collected their results in August they remain Academy students and therefore normal expectations and behaviour apply, particularly for those who wish to stay on in sixth form.

It fills me with a great sense of pride to see these students, your children, at this stage of their education and I feel a personal connection to them because they were in Year 7 when I started as Headteacher of Quarrendon School.
