Dear Parents and Carers,

RE: WEATHER-RELATED CLOSURES

As you will know, extremely high temperatures are forecast for Tuesday to Thursday this week, with a Met Office Red Warning in place for Wednesday and Thursday. Despite our relatively modern building, most rooms lack air conditioning and are already uncomfortable, with the Atrium currently at 42°C. Internal temperatures are likely to rise further over the coming days.

Therefore, to ensure student and staff safety and wellbeing, Aylesbury Vale Academy will move to Remote Learning and will be closed at the following times:

- **Tuesday 23 June:** Partial closure for Primary and Secondary children.

Preschool: Closed all day

Reception: Leave 1.00pm

Year 1 & 2: Leave 1.10pm

Year 3 & 4: Leave 1.20pm

Year 5 & 6: Leave 1.30pm

Year 7 - 13: Leave 1.25pm

Secondary students in receipt of Free School Meals can collect a packed lunch as they leave site or stay in an air-conditioned room to eat their lunch.

- **Wednesday 24 June:** Full site closure and Remote Learning.
- **Thursday 25 June:** Full site closure and Remote Learning.

We will inform parents and carers if school is open on **Friday 26 June**.

Primary Remote Learning

In primary children will be given home learning tasks by their teacher on the morning of **Tuesday 23 June** to take home with them. These tasks will be in line with the work that they would complete if they were in school.
