Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy Friday everyone.

This week has been jam packed with lots of amazing learning opportunities including the Year 6 children sitting their practice PIXL assessments. These provide us with great information to support our planning and future areas of study. As always the children were amazing and all took the week in their stride. We regularly comment in school just how brilliant the children are and this was a perfect example.

Sorry to moan as I understand this does not apply to all. Parking and general driving around the school continues to be a problem. One of out Year 2 children (6 years old) was extremely lucky this week when a car reversed to turn around in the road near the zebra crossing. Thank goodness there were parents there as the driver did not see the child. Please always drive and park considerately - and keep in mind how you would feel if your child was put in danger.

The car park remains locked in order to keep children safe. Please keep your children with you and do not let them scoot, ride or run around the carpark. We cannot always ensure that visitors aren't coming/leaving around the times when children are being collected. The carpark entrance needs to be kept clear at all times to enable vehicles (including emergency vehicles) to access the grounds.

We have been looking at road safety with lots of the children and recapping what we have previously covered in school. We ask that you reiterate the key messages at home and continue to talk with your children about keeping themselves safe at all times.


#### Reflection
