Dear Parents/Carers,

Mrs Paxton then gave us a beautiful nativity for our Years 1 and 2. As always this didn't disappoint, all our children did amazing in the roles that they were given. We are so proud to show off to our parents how brave our children are.

Next week, we will be celebrating children who have had 100% for the Autumn Term. As mentioned in previous correspondence this term, if your child is late after 9:00am, this generates a U mark on the register. A U mark means that your child will only have 50% attendance for that day. Therefore, even if your child has been in every day this term, they will not receive a certificate for 100% Autumn Term attendance if they have been late after 9:00am.

We are unable to amend our registers without justifiable cause as this guidance is set by the Department for Education. For example, reasons such as traffic or sleeping in are not considered a justifiable cause.

As stated in previous letters and newsletters, this is a national change to the attendance policy.
