Dear Parents/Carers,

January is always a tricky month after the excitement of the festive holidays, but the children have been doing really well. Year 4 are doing amazingly with their swimming lessons and there was a lot of excitement around the recent Author visit yesterday for all KST2 children.

Well done to the Year 6's who sat PIXL assessments this week, as always their attitude and behaviour was exemplary.

Reception classes will be having some special visitors on Monday, we have some lovely volunteer police officers coming in to talk to them all about their current topic.

Thank you for your patience whilst we imbed the new absence system. There are some tweaks to still be made so please bear with us. I've attached the flyer from county which explains more about the process that we need to follow and why some requests will be declined and potentially incur a fine. If you have any queries, please get in touch via the school office.

I am aware that I sound like a broken record, but please can we remind all parents, and those collecting children, not to park across the staff car park entrance or on the yellow lines out the front of the school. Our staff have to be able to get in and out at all times due to their own commitments and I know you think you will only be a minute, but this is often not the case. The entrance should not be blocked or used as a waiting bay. This week the swimming coach was not able to park in its designated space and we had to drop children in an area that we ordinarily wouldn't. Parking on these yellow lines is illegal and putting lives at risk.

We continue to have this horrible virus going around and unfortunately, I think it is one that lingers. We do have children, families and staff with autoimmune conditions and ask that you are mindful about when to send in your child and that follow the guidance from the NHS, please see link below.
