Dear Parents/Carers,

The nights have become darker and we are feeling that winter is just around the corner with fireworks on Wednesday night and the start of preparation for all the Christmas celebrations coming up in December. Although it has been quite mild, as the days get colder the children will need a coat and suitable shoes for any outdoor play.

We have quite high levels of sickness not only in the children but also the staff. Please can we remind all parents/carers to not send your child into school if they are not fit to be in school. This will help us to reduce the spread of any viruses and bugs as we move into the winter months.

If your child is off school, please email the attendance team on primaryattendance@theacademy.me to ensure that they are recorded onto the system correctly. Please do this before 9am otherwise you may receive an automated email chasing for a response. We do not monitor the phonelines for absences and if you call into the office, you will be directed to email in.

Please can we also ask that messages are not passed on at the gate to staff for any absences or important information. Staff are dealing with high numbers of children in a very short space of time and cannot be expected to pass all messages from all parents onto the relevant people, they often move from the gate to teach or directly into meetings. All other messages outside of attendance need to go via avapriary@theacademy.me

Parking as always is an issue, and we continue to get complaints from our neighbours about parking at drop off and pick up times. This is becoming increasingly more dangerous and riskier as the days get darker. Please can we ask all parents to park considerately and appropriately for a residential area. People should not be parking over or in peoples drives and should not be blocking access to roads or restricting the view of other cars trying to manoeuvre on the roads. 
We are working hard to improve attendance and reduce the number of late arrivals in school where children are missing significant amounts of learning time. This will be an evolving process but one of the first steps is to ensure that no child is signing into the Inventory system when they arrive in school, this should be completed by their accompanying adult. The office team will not be signing in children on parents' behalf any more so please ensure that you accompany your child to the office and sign them in correctly on the system. The same applies with children who are being collected for appointments etc. If your child walks to school and arrives late you will be notified of this and they will need to be signed in via the attendance team. Allowing children to sign into the system creates a safeguarding risk that we need to mitigate and ensures all children are signed in properly on the system. If you do not sign your child in, you may receive an automatic email chasing this up from the attendance team even though your child may be in school. This data is reported via the school census to the department of education and we will be using this to manage attendance moving forward.

A reminder that we have school photos next **Friday 14 November**. Sibling photos will be done first thing followed by the individual photos. Please ensure that your child arrives to school on time to ensure that any

sibling photos are completed, we cannot guarantee this for late arrivals. All children must be smartly dressed in full school uniform there will be no PE that day for any classes. Please ensure that your child has a jumper or cardigan with them to wear for their photo.

We have our remembrance service next week where we remember all those brave service men and women who fought and continue to serve and protect our country.

A reminder that children who attend scouts, sea cadets or any similar organisation are able to wear their uniform for the day and be involved in the service as per the letter sent out last week. It will be lovely to see them all in their uniforms to pay their respects, we will be taking a photo for the Newsletter next week.
