Dear Parents/Carers,

Hopefully the weather report I heard on the radio will be accurate this Bank Holiday weekend and we may see the sunshine!

We were joined in school this week by footballers Matty Taylor and Nick Lacey from Youth Dreams Project (YDP) who run our Monday and Wednesday football sessions. We hope to grow this provision and offer many more groups.

These assessments will be conducted in school and in no way define the wonderful children we have here at AVA.
