

**Dear Parents/Carers** 

I am writing to you on a Thursday this week as I anticipate tomorrow being super busy!

Tomorrow (Friday) we finish school (at the normal times) for our half term break. This break will be unusual as it includes the double bank holiday for the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. We will be celebrating this in school tomorrow. Berryfields Parish Council are holding an event at the new hall in Roman Park which looks fantastic- please support them if possible. This is on 2nd June.

When we return to school on 6th June we will be finalising the new classes for September 2022. All children have discussed this with their current teachers. We are also very excited to welcome Mrs Zucchi to our team. She will be teaching in Early Years.

Swimming will continue after the half term break for Eagles class. This will run as per this half term on a Monday afternoon.

Over half the school have never participated in a sports day in-front of spectators and may find this overwhelming. We want to get back to running these annual activities but must re-introduce them with care in order to give everyone a positive experience.
