Dear Parents/Carers,

What a difference a bit of sunshine makes!

Today we close our doors for the May half term break. I say it every term, but this half term has flown by. We have had a busy one but looking forward next half term looks even busier.

Sadly, parking continues to be an issue out the front of the school. We have seen many incidents of dangerous driving and parking this week alone and another near miss. Please remember to park legally and carefully, the people at risk (adults and children) are members of our school community.

Recently I have had to make the hard decision to cancel some school trips and visits due to financial reasons. On average the cost of trips has doubled over the past year and schools are no longer in a financial position where we can subsidise these visits. We have many families in our community struggling at the moment and as a school we need to be inclusive and offer experiences that all of our children can access.

We will continue to run our school led clubs as cheaply as possible despite the rise in costs and are trying to be creative in exposing children to fun and new experiences, above and beyond the daily curriculum. Unfortunately, without enough payments some trips and visits cannot happen and therefore will be cancelled or changed. This is a sensitive issue for many of our families and we should be considerate to the needs and situations of others. All monies paid will be refunded if a trip or visit doesn't happen. I understand that this is disappointing for many of you but is sadly being reflected across many areas of our community.

It reminds us that God has made an alliance with us; He reaches out to us and He does not leave us. This is the Good News that the Spirit comes to remind us of.


A prayer for Pentecost
