We are recommending that children wear PE kit and trainers to school week. We will be


welcoming a range of visitors as well as trying many sports.



We pray that all people feel called to find their role in protecting our oceans.


We pray and hope that each of us feels a renewed sense of connectedness with the ocean and its many gifts to us.
