Year 5 Climate Change



Summer 2

Language: Spanish and French

Pupils will be taught to read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing.

Music

Pupils will be taught to appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions focusing on tribal music.

Links in Learning

In Year 3, as part of their work in Geography children explore what climate change is and use maps to explore Europe and identify animals in different countries. In Year 6 as part of their work in Science children will further investigate humans looking at the functions of internal organs and recognise the impact of lifestyle choices on the body.

Geography

Pupils will explore The Amazon, with particular focus on the impact of climate change. Pupils will also explore tribes within the rainforest.

Computing

Pupils will explore a series of smaller modules introducing a range of software. This includes computer art, an introduction to Publisher, blogging and vlogging and social media.

Science

Living things and their habitats

Pupils will be taught to describe the differences in the life cycles of a mammal, an amphibian, an insect and a bird, and describe the life process of reproduction in some plants and animals.

Animals including humans

Pupils will be able to describe the changes as humans develop to old age.
