
Science

Light

Pupils will be taught to recognise that light appears to travel in straight lines. They will use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye. They will also explain that we see things because light travels from light sources to our eyes or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes and use the idea that light travels in straight lines to explain why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

Pupils will be taught to improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing, painting with a range of materials. Children will explore cubism and perspective

RE

Do clothes express beliefs? We will be exploring e whether clothing rules and restrictions can express belief and give people a sense of identity
