

Main Screen

Once logged in you will see the main screen in EduLink One, where you will be able to navigate through the different sections to view a selection of information about your child/children. Please see an example of the main screen below.



If you have more than one student in school, it's easy to switch between each one. Just select which would like to view in the top right-hand corner.

The messages button will let you know if you have any unread messages from the school.



Overview

Below is an overview on what each section of EduLink offers:

	Account Information – Basic details (including address, telephone number, year, registration group and form tutor).
	Behaviour - The behaviour button will give you access to view behaviour records, detentions and lesson behaviour, which have been assigned to your child. Information on detentions and graphs on lesson behaviour are also shown.
	Documents/Reports – Within this section you are able to download current and historical grade and written reports. This will be downloaded as a pdf.
	Forms – Forms that are sent out by the school can be located here.
	Timetables – here you can view your child's daily and weekly timetable and the times of the school day.
	Links – Links to useful websites; the academy website, ParentPay, mental health and wellbeing sites.
	Noticeboard – In this section you will be able to view school notices and bulletins.
	Homework – Homework is set by teachers in MS teams, but is synced to EduLink and can be viewed here (view only).
	Attendance – In this section you can see your child's daily attendance, attendance by lesson and monthly and yearly attendance.
	Achievements - This section is where you can view information on positive achievements that have been awarded to your child. Very similar to the behaviour section, you are able to see who awarded the points and the reason for the award



	<p>Contacts – Here you can view the contact information that we have on record for you. Please update your contact information using the 'Update Information' section (above) or contact the academy at enquiries@theacademy.me if you have any queries.</p>
	<p>Messages – Here you can read any messages from school staff. You are also able to compose a new message to staff by clicking on the green 'New Message' icon where it will let you select from your child's current Teachers, Form Tutor or Head of Year.</p>
