Walking

Why Walk?

Walking is a fantastic way to stay healthy; it's easy to fit into everyday life, it's free and doesn't require any equipment other than a comfortable pair of shoes.

A journey of under two miles can be walked in around 30-40 minutes and would significantly reduce carbon emissions, congestion and improve local air quality.

Walking brings high streets and communities to life, boosting our local economies.

To fit more walking into your day, why not:

- Get off the bus one stop earlier and walk the last part of your journey.

Cycling

Aylesbury has a network of cycle routes called the Gemstone routes which are safe, mostly off-road and easy to cycle with family and friends, on the commute or for leisure.

The routes connect residential areas in Aylesbury with the town centre, attractions and amenities, and there is plenty of cycle parking available.

Waddesdon Greenway

A walking and cycling route connecting Aylesbury Vale Parkway, existing cycle routes, and the Berryfields housing estate to Waddesdon Manor and Waddesdon village.

A 4km path, useable year round, is a pleasure to travel. The route is suitable for wheelchairs and prams and features regularly placed benches for those who need a rest.

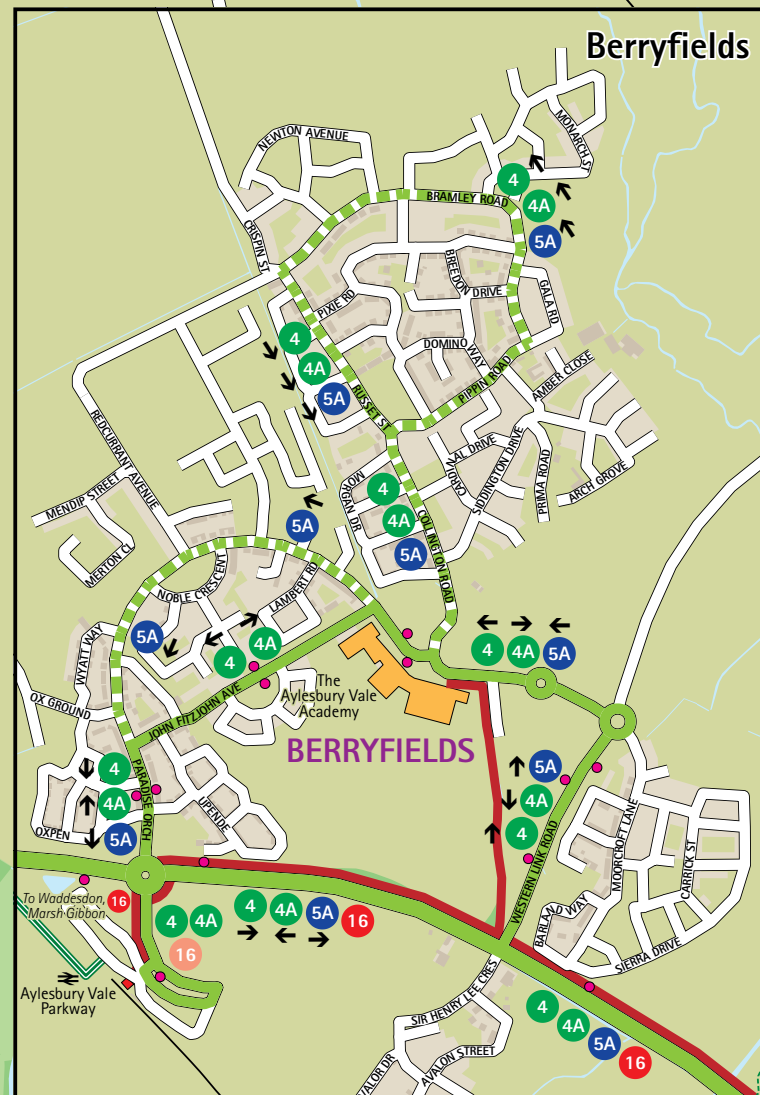

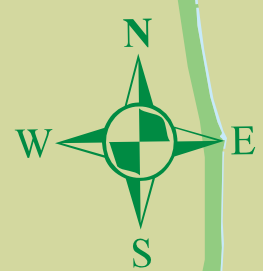

Combined Cycle Routes

Stoke Mandeville Way

'Stoke Mandeville Way' is a level, step-free accessible route between Aylesbury town centre and Stoke Mandeville village, suitable for use by most disabled or older people, especially those with reduced mobility, including scooter and wheelchair users and people who use a walker, crutches or sticks.

The route is 5 km long (3.1 miles) but seats have been provided along the whole route for people who need to rest for a while, and the route is clearly signposted to help people with mild vision loss.
