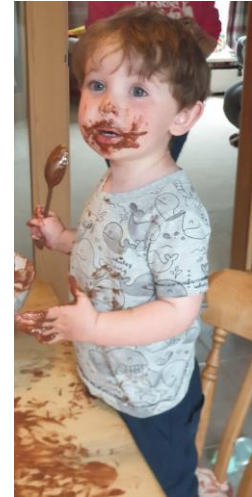


Mrs Foulger's Weekly Update

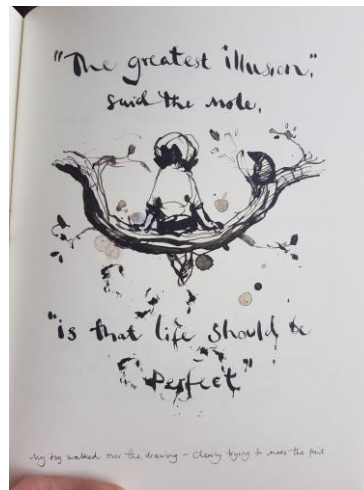
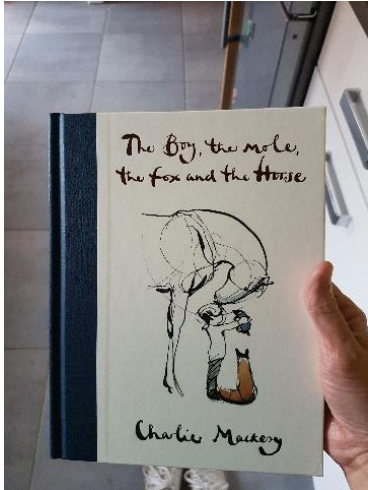
Doctor Dave and Doctor Steve have been practising their skills this week!
