Autumn 1 (2022-2023)

Art and Design

Pupils will learn basic sketching of African patterns and create inspired Graffiti.

Music and Dance

Pupils will be taught to appreciate and understand a wide range of high-quality live and recorded music drawn from different traditions focusing on African drumming, African call and response songs and tribal dancing.

Computing

Pupils will develop their typing skills and explore E-Safety.

Science

Properties and changes of materials.
Pupils will be taught to compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties, including their hardness, solubility, transparency, conductivity (electrical and thermal), and response to magnets.

RE

Understanding Different Cultures (Islam)

Pupils will explore *The Last Piece of Paper in the World*, considering the rules within the Qur'an and discussing whether such rules impact upon greater understanding and awareness within the *Black Lives Matter* movement.

PSHE

Celebrating Differences – to explore differences in people's race, religion and appearance and to recognise examples of bullying.
